STATE CERTIFICATION – NFPA 1001 Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications 2019 Edition. For qualification at Level I, the firefighter candidate shall meet the general knowledge requirements in NFPA 1001 including all, live fire requirements and – **NFPA 1072 Standard for Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction Emergency Response Personnel Professional Qualifications 2017 Edition.** Chapter 4 Awareness.

FIREFIGHTER I PROBOARD certification requirements: Hold Pro Board or IFSAC certification in Hazardous Materials Awareness Chapter 4 and Hazardous Materials Operations Chapter 5 and Mission Specific competencies in 6.2 Personal Protective Equipment Chapter 6, and Section 6.6 Product Control, NFPA 1072 *"Hazardous Materials/WMD Emergency Response Personnel Professional Qualifications"* 2017 Edition. The candidate shall hold the required level of emergency medical services as determined by the AHJ in accordance with NFPA 1001.
